Tactical Mast Reassembly

Warning: Be careful tilting the mast with the bottom cap removed, as there is a risk that all the mast sections might suddenly slide out at once. Keep the mast horizontal until you are ready to remove the sections. Then tilt the mast gently, with your hand over the end, to ensure the sections exit the mast in a controlled manner.

The photos show a Tactical Mini. The 7000 is larger and has more sections, but the method is the same.

• Remove the top cap



• Unscrew the base cap





Remove the Shock absorber. The easiest way is to push the sections from the top of the
mast. The shock absorber will be pushed out. If the mast is tilted or vertical, the sections
will slide out of the mast quickly when the shock absorber is not in place. Ensure you
do not trap your fingers or damage any surface under the mast.





• Sections can be removed from the bottom (screw-cap) end of the mast





- Before reassembly, ensure the sections are clean and dry. We recommend using a soft cloth or a paper towel for this.
- Sections must be inserted into the mast in the correct order and the correct orientation.

Slide the largest inner section into the outermost mast section. The painted end of the section should go in first. Then slide in the next largest section. Note the unpainted end of the section must be at the screw-cap end of the mast.

Repeat until all sections are refitted. Afterwards, the bottom of the mast should look similar to this photo:



• Push in the Shock Absorber





• Screw on the base cap



- Replace the top cap.
- Your mast is now reassembled and ready to use.
